The Cool Kids program is evidence based cognitive behavioural intervention that directly addresses the core aspects of anxiety and its maintenance in children. It has been developed by experts in the area at the Centre of Emotional Health at Macquarie University in Sydney.

The program helps children to recognise emotions such as fear, stress and anxiety, helps them to challenge beliefs associated with feeling nervous, and encourages them to gradually engage with fearful activities in more positive ways.

WIPE OUT WASTE AT MIRANDA PUBLIC SCHOOL

Students in 5/6M and 5/6T have been collaborating on an initiative to reduce waste at Miranda Public School. They have called their project “*Wipe Out Waste – together we can smash the trash!*” and it all starts this week with our first Wipe Out Waste Wednesday. Students have been asked to bring lunches to school each Wednesday with no plastic waste, and instead use re-usable containers and pack “nude food”. Our project all started with a waste audit that was conducted during Term 2. We were all shocked to see just how much plastic waste goes into our playground bins every day!

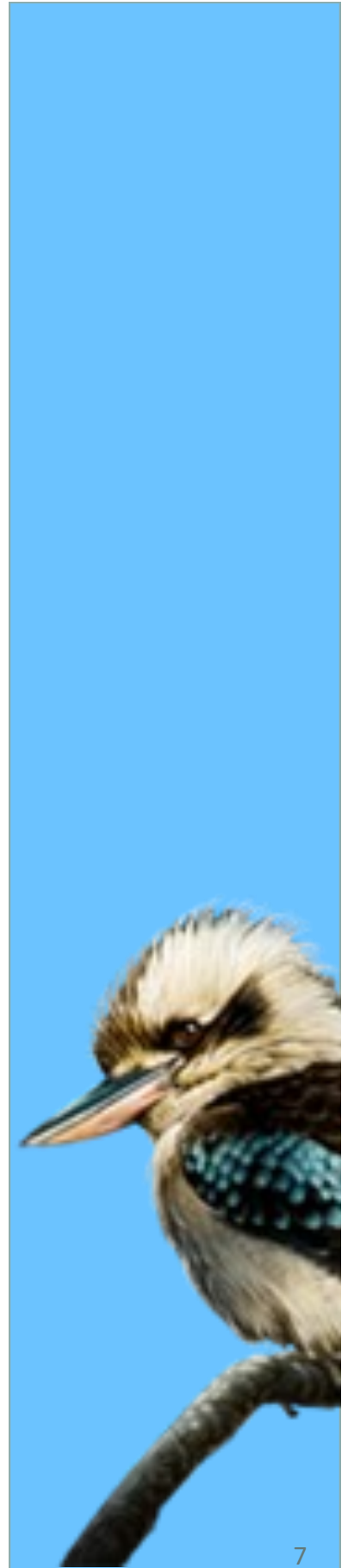
Reputation:

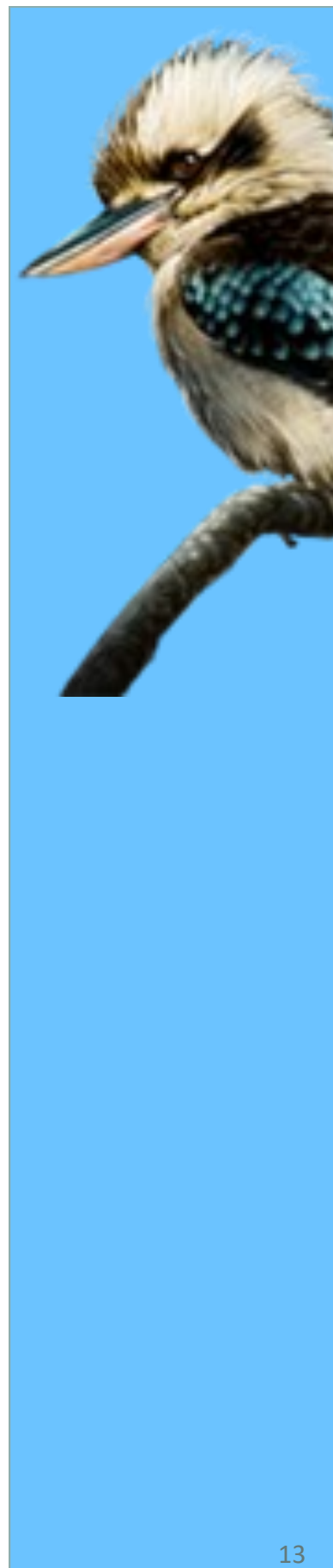

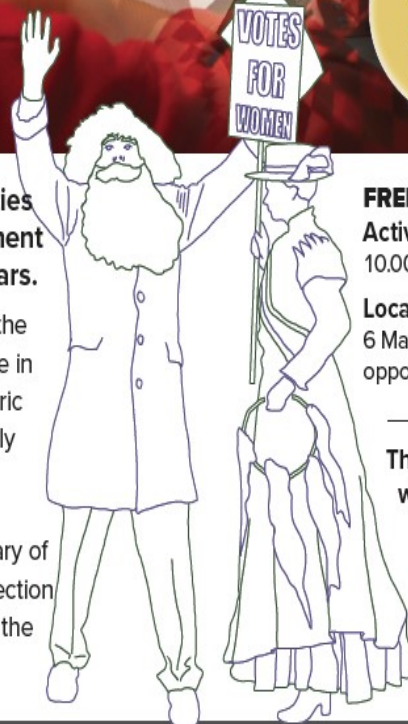
