
Kindergarten Orientation

Well done to all of our students, who came in costume and enjoyed a great Halloween mufti day yesterday. Lots of fun was had by all.


The money raised yesterday will go towards the purchase of possum boxes to home and keep safe, the many possums that have taken sanctuary in our school gum trees.




