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# Miranda Public School Swimming Carnival 10<sup>th</sup> February 2020 - Additional Information Please retain this note for reference

The Swimming Carnival will be at Sans Souci Leisure Centre commencing at 10.00am.

All children in Years 3 to 6 are required to attend as part of normal school activities. Any 8 year olds in Year 2 who can confidently swim 50 metres, in a race format, may also attend.

Students must be at school by 9.10am. The bus will depart at 9.30am. Students will be back at school before 3.10pm.

The cost is \$16.50 which includes pool entry, bus fares and equipment hire at the carnival. Parents and carers are welcome to join us on the day.

There is a pool entry fee for spectators of \$2.50, paid directly to the pool on the day.

Students will need to bring recess, lunch and a bottle of water from home as no lunch orders will be taken. Limited canteen facilities will be available on the day, please bring **NO MORE THAN \$10**, as we cannot guarantee money will be safe.

Casual clothes in appropriate house colours may be worn, otherwise students must wear their school sports uniform. Appropriate footwear must be worn, <u>slides</u>, <u>sandals or thongs are NOT acceptable</u>.

Swimming costumes are to be worn under their clothing. Students are to bring a change of underwear, a plastic bag and their towel. A hat and sunscreen must be also be worn.

For those students who receive permission to race, a short swim test will take place at the beginning of the day to demonstrate their ability.

Swimmers of all levels and ability will be catered for during the carnival with unstructured water activities and free swim time offered.
